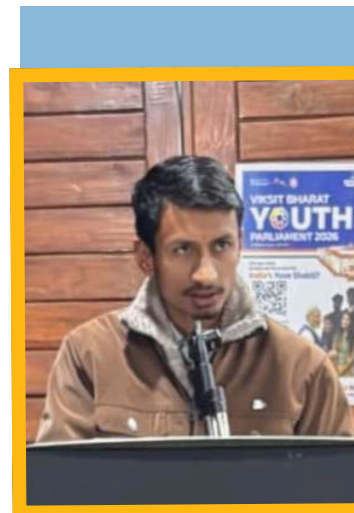
Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament

National Integration Camp

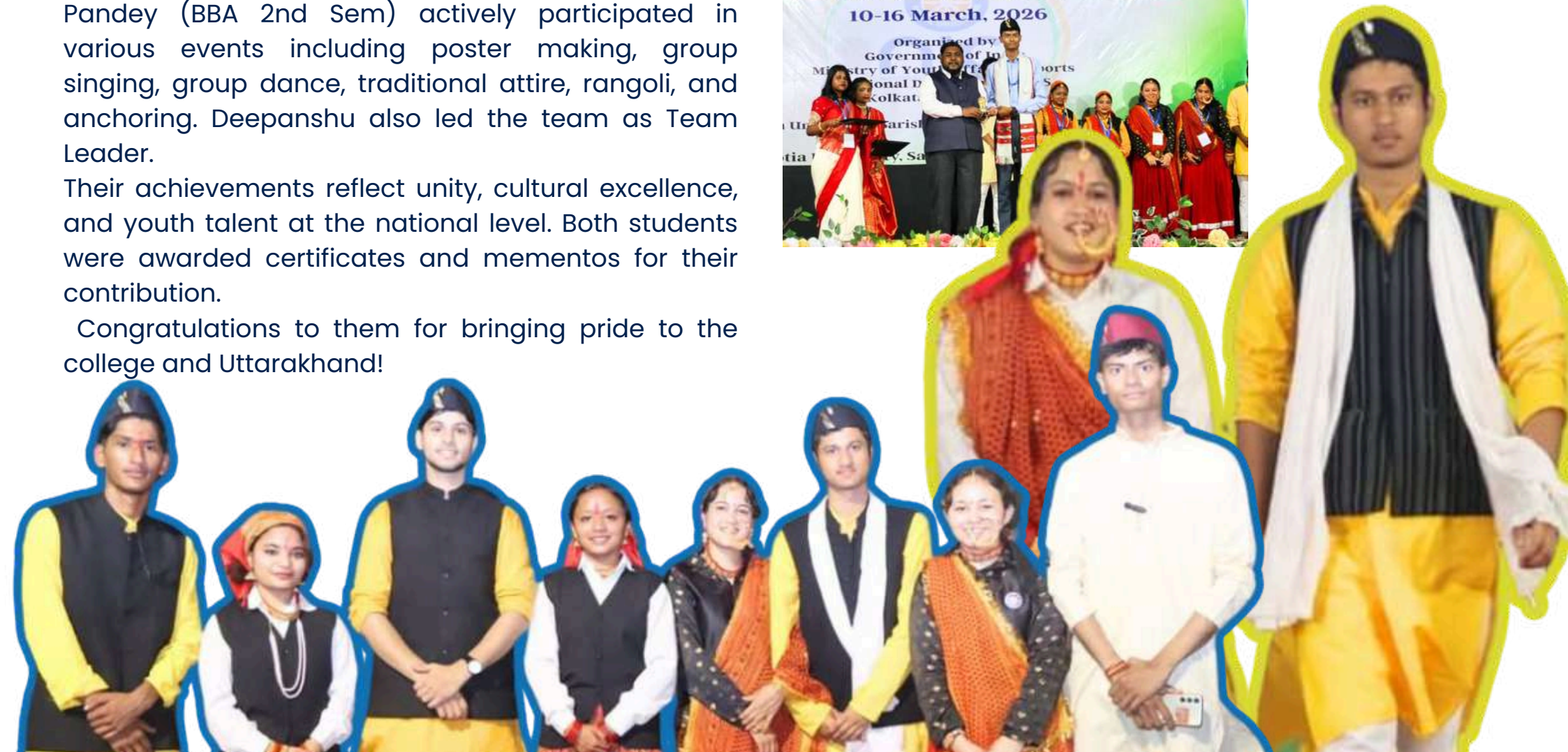

The activity was conducted under the supervision of Ms. Shubhangi Shandilya (Public Relations Officer), and Mr. Girish Chandra (Assistant Professor).

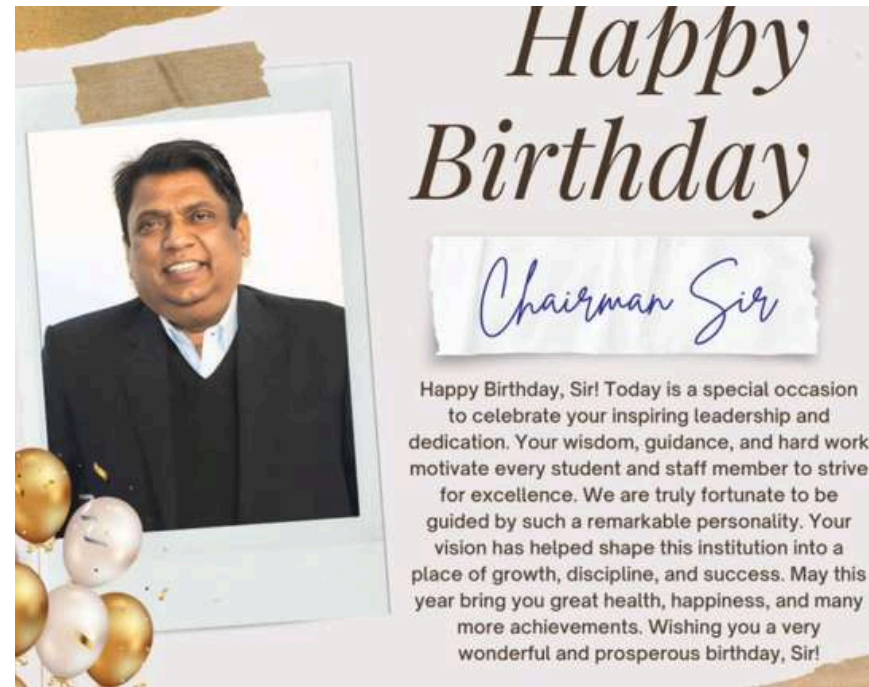

The session was highly informative and inspiring, motivating students to contribute strategically towards regional and national development.

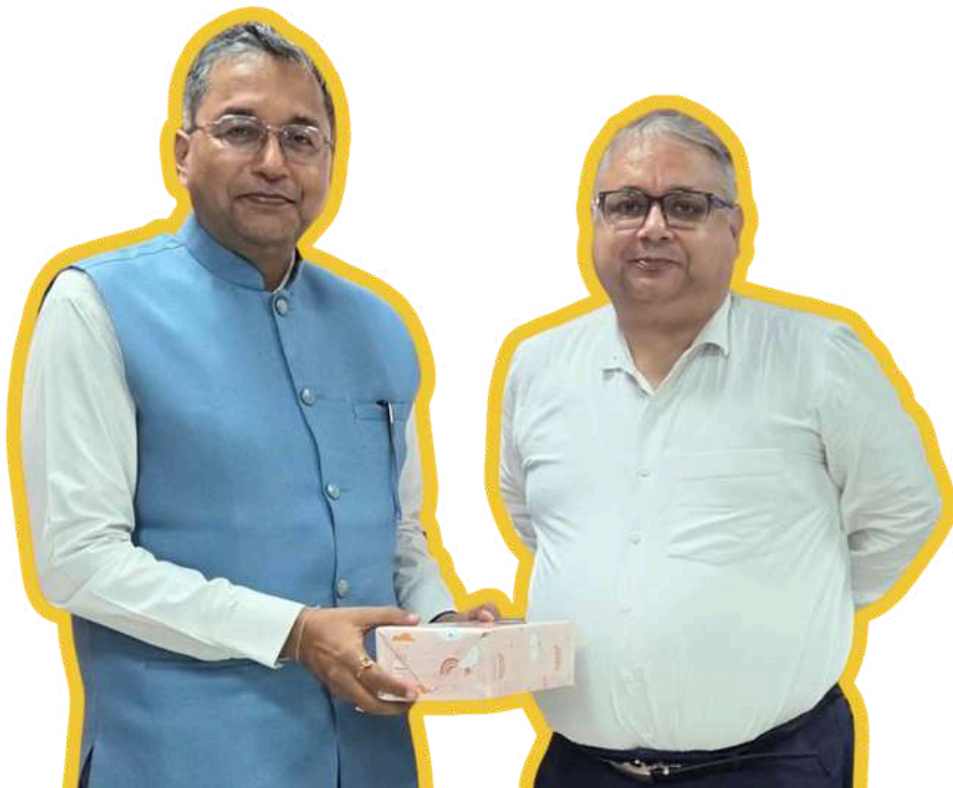


Commerce-management

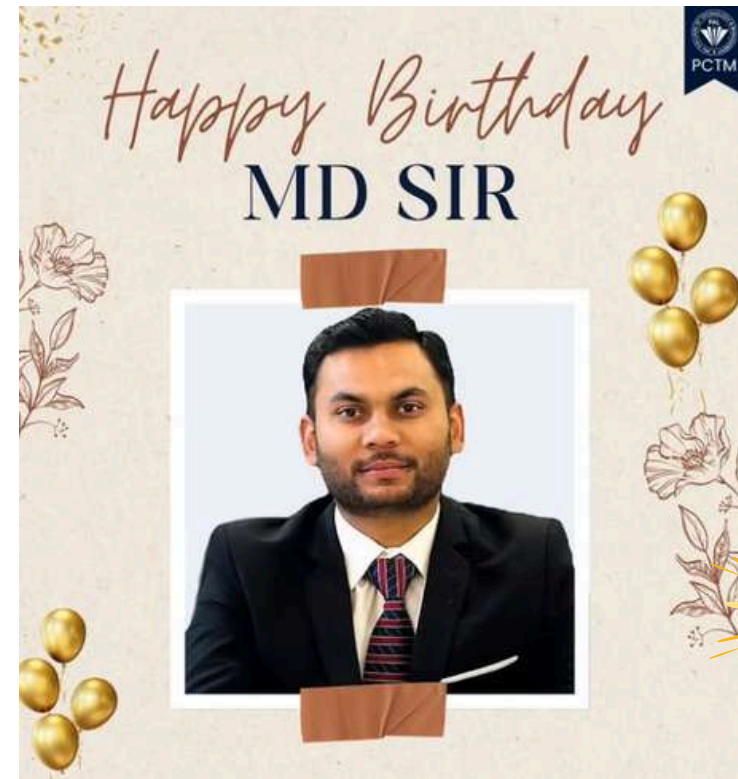

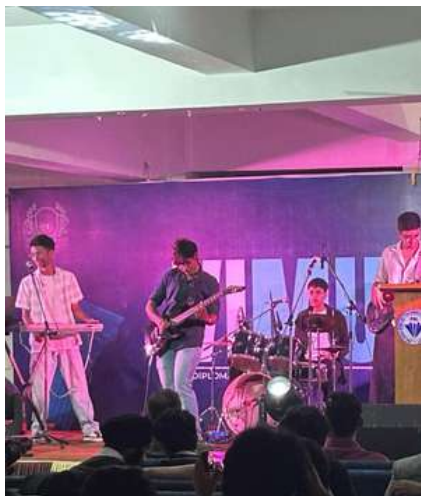
VIMUN 2026 Begins with a Grand Inauguration at PCTM!

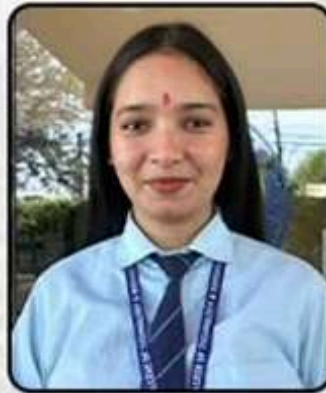

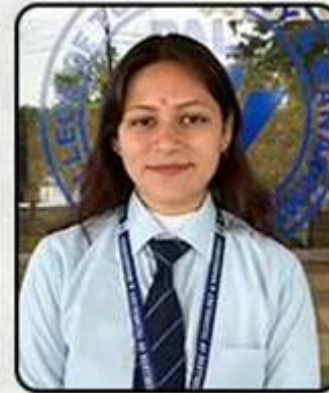
