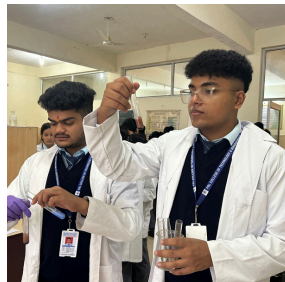
## Children's Day celebration

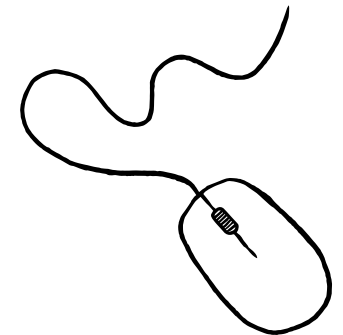
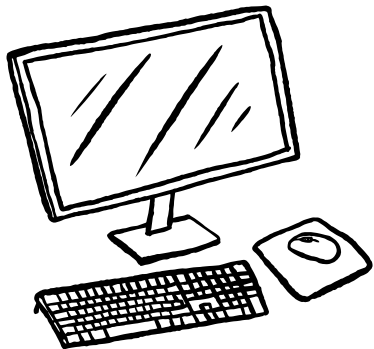
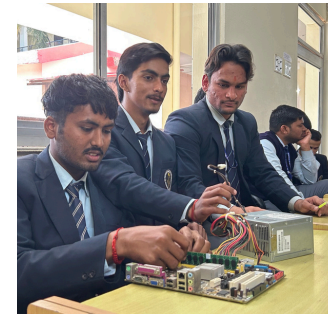
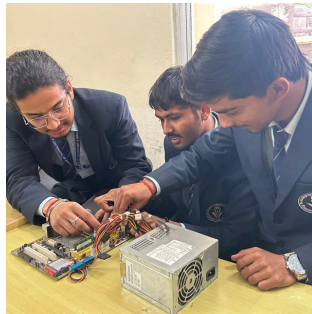
## PCTM Students Attend Digital Marketing Workshop at DLP
